SKILLS AND STRATEGIES 4 MAIN IDEAS

- SKILL PRACTICE 1** pages 10-11
1. **Sentence 1** gives you your first hypothesis (H1) for the main idea. It is a good indicator of the main idea. Keep looking for some evidence. The first example that follows illustrates the weaknesses of relying on the answer to one problem of choice, as you do not need to verify your H1 for the main idea.
 2. **Sentence 1** gives you your first hypothesis (H1) for the main idea. There was an increase of interest in and usage for personal computers. **Sentence 2** introduces a new idea. The result of this interest and usage was programs on the computer, so you decide to revise your first hypothesis. This gives you your new H2. This is a good hypothesis because it has worked for personal computers, like other programs and software since 80.
 3. **Sentence 2** gives you your first hypothesis (H1) for the main idea along with the development of personal computers. **Sentence 3** introduces a new idea. The growth of personal computers resulted in more of these children. So you revise your first hypothesis. This gives you H2. The emphasis on personal computers is not part of the H2 because children who do every day simple activities. The following sentence in the paragraph supports your H2, by explaining in detail how personal computers were the children.
