13th	1. Slavery and involuntary servitude are banned in the United States, except as a punishment for a crime of which the convict has been convicted.	2. <i>Fisher v. United States</i> , 413 U.S. 1 (1973). The court ruled that Congress has the power to require the production of documents in a criminal case.
2nd	3. The president has the right to pardon and have mercy on those for whom he pardons.	4. <i>Clinton v. City of New York</i> , 524 U.S. 417 (1998). The Court ruled that the president's pardon power extends to federal judges who have been impeached and removed from office.
3rd	1. forbids the quartering of soldiers in private houses without the consent of the owner.	Not Applicable.
4th	6. Facts must be established by probable cause, including and requiring a search warrant must be obtained with probable cause.	7. <i>Fruit of the Poisonous Tree</i> , 392 U.S. 231 (1968). The Court ruled that evidence obtained from a search that was illegal at the time is inadmissible in court.
